

Sunbonnet Sue (right) Paper-Pieced Block

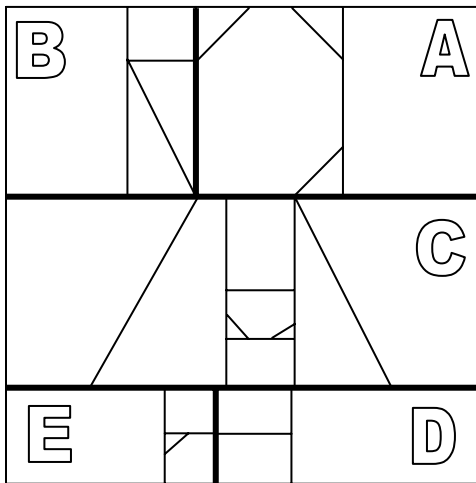
Our paper-pieced version of the classic Sunbonnet Sue pattern has a finished size of 4 inches x 4 inches. In this pattern, she faces to the right.

Materials needed are:

- 4" square of background fabric
- scraps for the bonnet and dress
- black scraps for the shoes
- skin-tone scraps for the hands & legs

Construction:

1. Piece the separate blocks.
2. Sew the main seam between block D and block E (indicated by a '1' on the edge of the separate pieces).
3. Sew the main seam between block A and block B (indicated by a '2' on the edge of the separate pieces).
4. Sew the main seam between block A/B and block C (indicated by a '3' on the edge of the separate pieces).
5. Sew the main seam between block A/B/C and block D/E (indicated by a '4' on the edge of the separate pieces).



Color Codes:

- Z Background color
- S Hand & Leg color
- F Shoe color
- B Bonnet color
- D Dress color
